### ABOUT TITLE 1

Title 1 is a federally funded program that supports students from low-income households throughout the nation. Funds are distributed to schools based on the percentage of students who qualify for free or reduced lunch.

### WHO PARTICIPATES?

Dayville offers a schoolwide Title I program, meaning ALL of our students are eligible to receive services. While many schools target the most in-need students, a schoolwide program allows for each opportunity to invest in EACH student through a tiered support system.

### GOAL

Just like our District's vision, the goal of Title 1 is to ensure high levels of learning and growth for each student.

Funds are used to improve student achievement through:

- Classified paraprofessionals to support reading & math K-6
- Counseling services
- Professional Development for staff
- Expanded opportunities for students with electives & community partnerships

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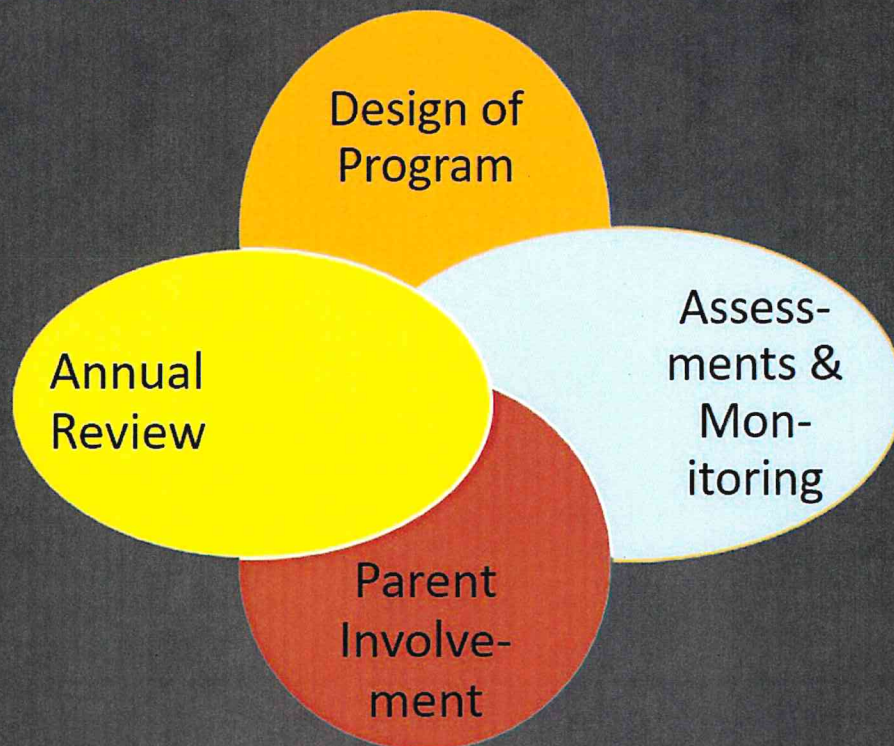
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# Title 1-A Program Requirements
