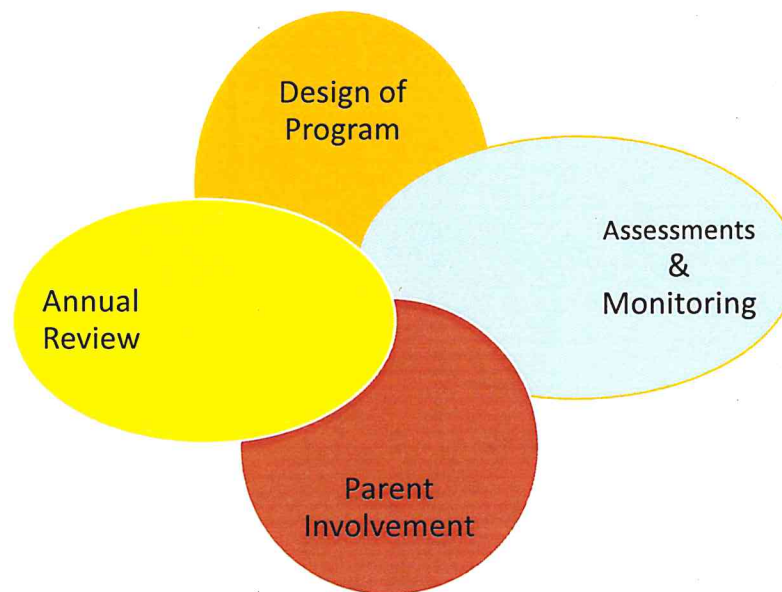
Title I-A Program

- What is “Title I-A”?
 - Title I-A is United States Government’s largest education assistance program for schools.
 - Funds are used to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math.
 - Extra help (in addition to what they learn during math and reading time in the classroom)
 - Funding provided under ESEA

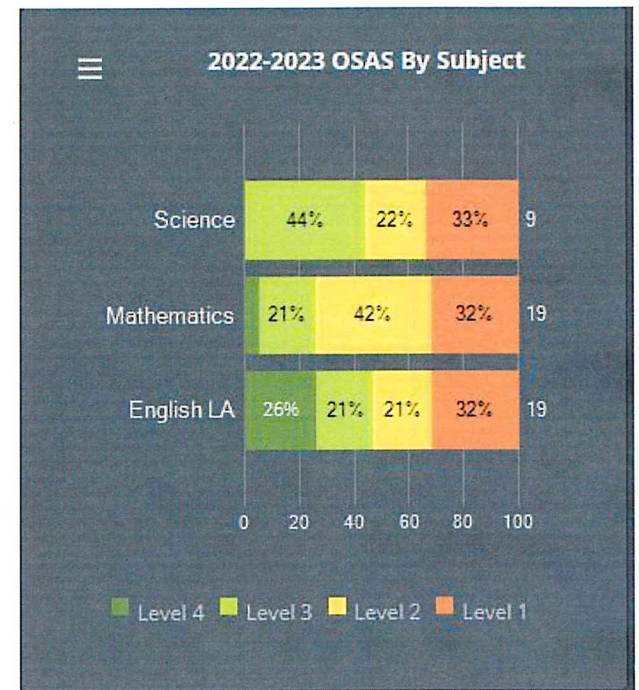
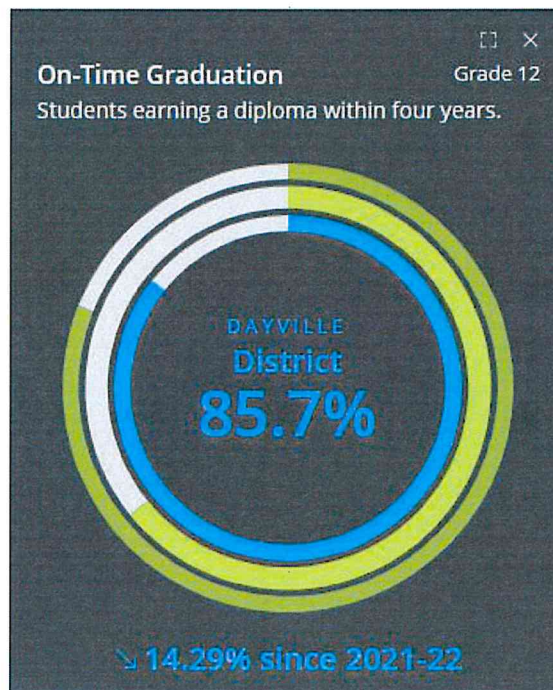
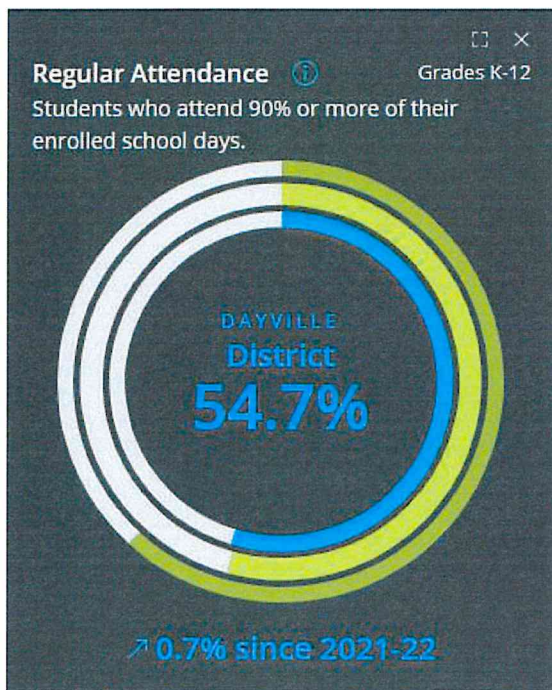
Parent/Guardian Rights Under ESSA

- Review school's Title I program and make suggestions
- Participate in school activities

Design of our Program

- Schoolwide Program
 - *Dayville School District offers a schoolwide Title I program, meaning ALL of our students are eligible to receive services. While many schools target the most in-need students, a schoolwide program allows for each opportunity to invest in EACH student through a tiered support system.*
- What does our program look like?
 - *Just like our District's vision, the goal of Title 1 is to ensure high levels of learning and growth for each student.*
 - *Paraprofessionals provide "push-in" supports in reading and math classrooms for K-6 students in need of interventions.*
 - *Funds are used to improve student achievement through:*
 - *Classified paraprofessionals to support reading & math K-6*
 - *Counseling services*
