- Repairs and upgrades to the high school including security and ADA improvements, roof, plumbing and waste water drainage renovations		
- Repairs and upgrades to the elementary school including safety improvements, electrical, wiring and lighting renovations		
- Improvements to the stage area		
- Pay issuance costs		
Bonds would mature in 16 years or less from the date of issuance. If approved, the tax rate is estimated to be \$1.68 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value. Actual rates may vary based upon interest rates incurred and changes in assessed value.
